Waste Clearing of Canals Adjoining Wings Building Nigeria: Lango's team participated in clearing the blocked canals beside The Wings Office. Waste materials, such as plastics and plants, obstruct the free flow of water causing potential flooding upstream along the entire drainage system along Ozumba Mbadiwe Avenue (a major road in Victoria Island, Lagos). The initiative cleared 186kg of non-biodegradable plastics to enable the free flow of drainage water.

Water tank repairs at a local school

Nigeria: Lango repaired an abandoned overhead tank with a rusted platform at a local school in Lagos and provided water tank maintenance and plumbing works.

Krowor academic scholarship Ghana: The Bursary Scheme is an academic scholarship programme to support brilliant students in need of financial assistance in selected government's schools within Junction Mall's catchment area in Accra. The support focuses on the pupils' needs for books, school bags, uniforms, and footwear. Sixty students from six schools will enroll.

Healthy Tenants, Happy Customers Ghana: Accra Financial Centre and Standard Chartered Building held wellness days where building employees and tenants' staff were screened for health assessments such as diabetes, cholesterol, BMI, and workout sessions were held. Junction Mall and Manda Hill in collaboration with Decathlon continue to provide periodic fitness and workout events for the greater community.

Beach Clean Up & Aerobics Ghana: Junction Mall's management in Accra collaborates with Decathlon on a monthly beach and community clean-up exercise. This is a healthy living initiative to help keep our environment clean and develop a personal fitness attitude.

Krowor Farmers Day Ghana: Ghana annually celebrates its hardworking farmers on the first Friday of December. Lango annually supports the Krowor Municipality, where Junction Mall is located, with gift items for deserving and hardworking farmers.

Homowo Celebrations Ghana: Howomo literally means "hooting at Hunger", is a ceremony that supports the King of Nungua, the Wolumo and Otinor Chief (the immediate community of Junction Mall) with donations. Lango hosts the Homowo Arts and Cultural Festival which is an avenue for indigenous start-ups to exhibit their locally made products.

Donate a Book Campaign Zambia: Manda Hill in Lusaka provided support to the Donate a Book Campaign through a donation. The campaign benefited community schools across the country. The books that were collected from the initiative include textbooks and exercise books. Over 20 schools in Central and Lusaka Province have benefited from the campaign.
